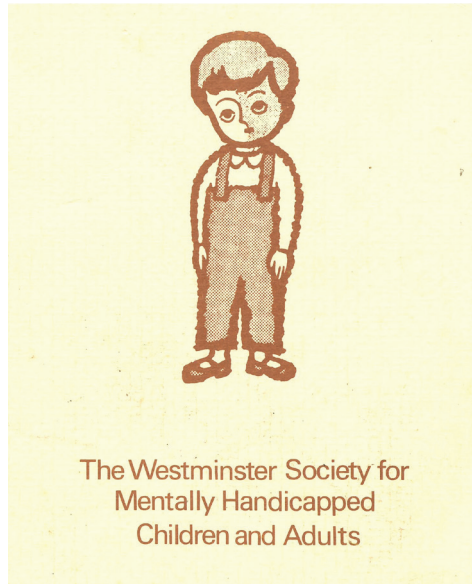


The Westminster Society Logo Development 1962-2020

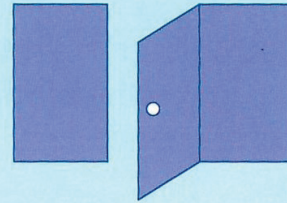
